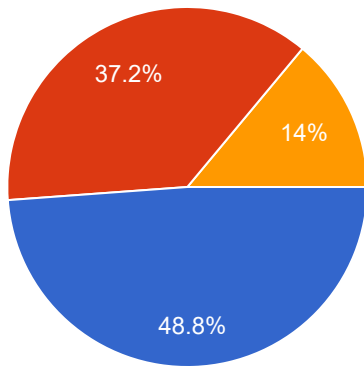


# 2018 Seed Voting Results

43 responses

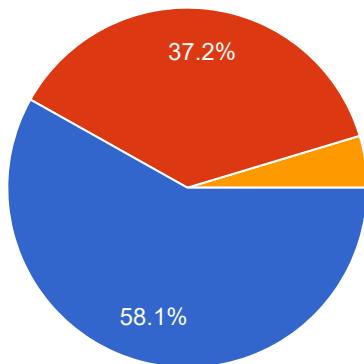


- Highest seed present (current rule)

43 responses

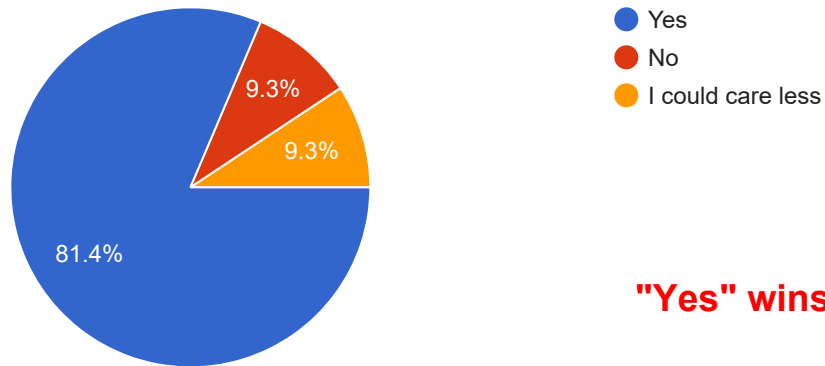


- 2 players in the group/4some (current rule)

**"2 players in the group required to concede a putt" wins**

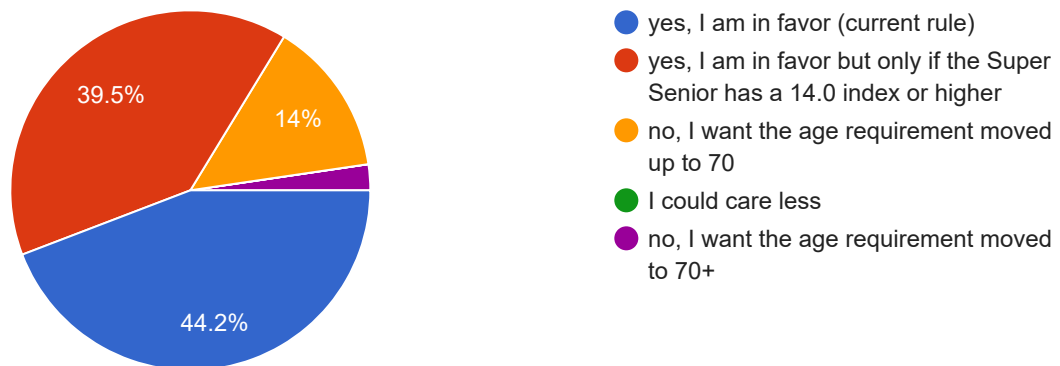
## Should we implement the 2019 USGA rule changes that are due to go in effect in 2019?

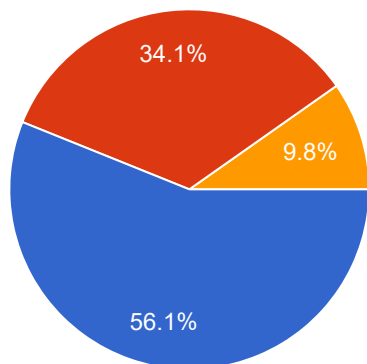
## On 375 yd+ par 4's, Super Seniors (65 and older) are allowed to move up 1 tee box?

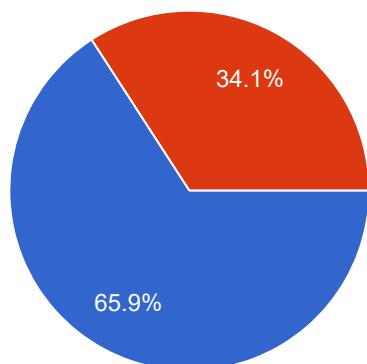


- Senior player must play tee box according to the yardage posted on scorecard (current)
